GIFT AID GIVING - RECLAIMING TAX WITH YOUR HELP

The Government changed the rules on Gift Aid from 6 April 2000. Now all donations from a taxpayer, whether large or small, regular or one-off, can count for Gift Aid, and tax reclaimed by a charity. This is an important benefit for the Society that, with your help, can swell our funds without cost to you.

There is a simple form for you to complete at the bottom of the page, which will enable the Society to take advantage of these rules. One of the good things about the system is that you only have to fill in the form once to cover all your giving to the Society both now and in the future.

Provided that you are a taxpayer, and will pay at least as much tax as the Society recovers on the donations you give it during the year then please complete this form. If you have a query about Gift Aid as it affects you, please call the Society Treasurer, James Duberly on 01480 860225.

If making a donation now. If you pay income tax or capital gains tax and are making a donation now please complete this form and send it with your gift to the Society's accounting officer, Mrs. Maureen Peters, 189 High Street, Great Wakering, Essex SS3 0EA.

If not making a donation now. If you want to be registered with the charity for donations you intend to make in the future please complete the form and send it to the Society's Honorary Treasurer, James Duberly, The Cottage, 25 Main Road, Stonely, St. Neots, Cambs PE19 5EH so that all your future giving can count as Gift Aid.

You should note that as a Gift Aid donor you need to be paying income or capital gains tax equal to the amount of tax deducted from your donations in each tax year (currently 28p for every £1 you give). Remember to let the Society know if your tax position changes.
